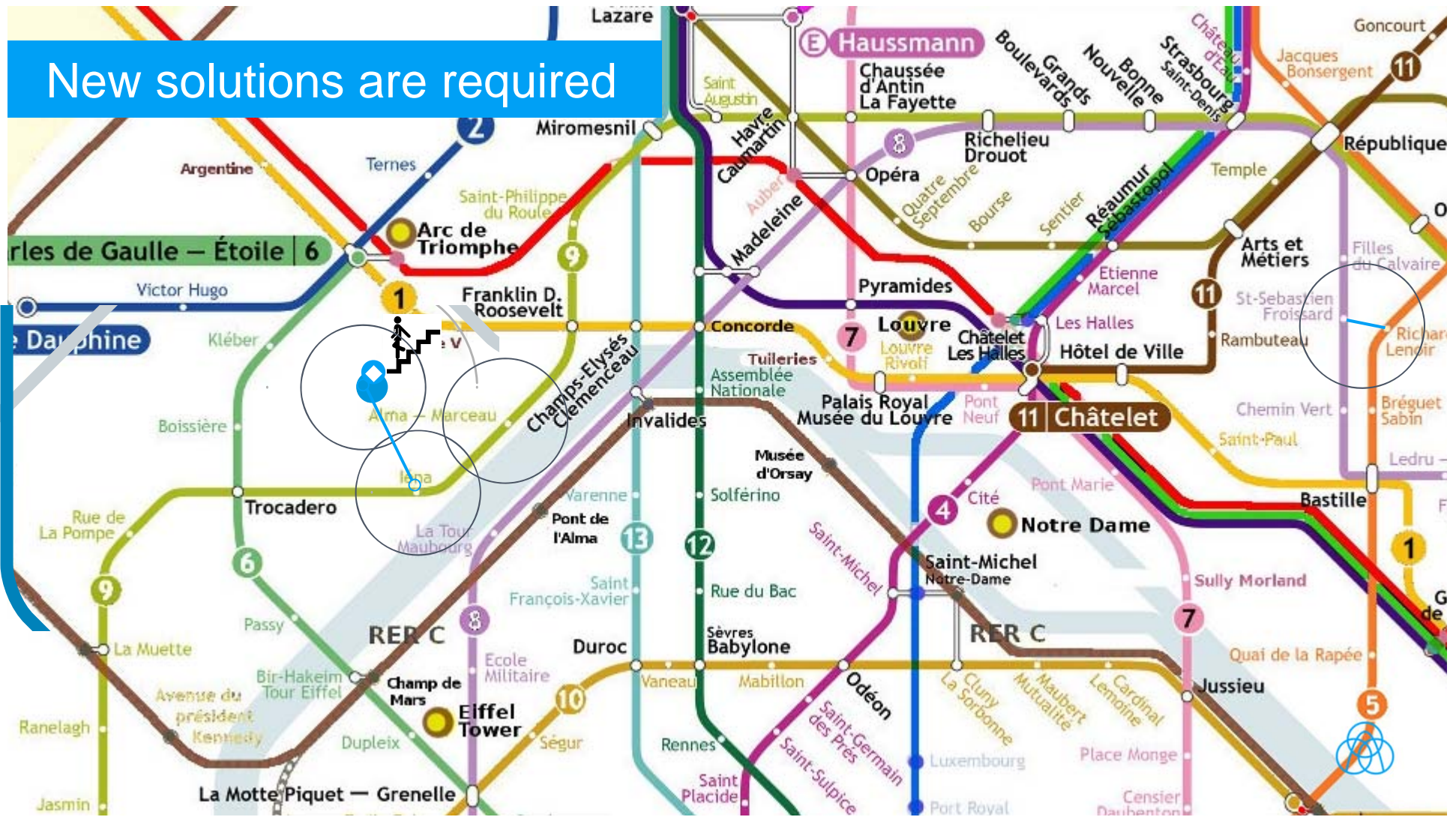

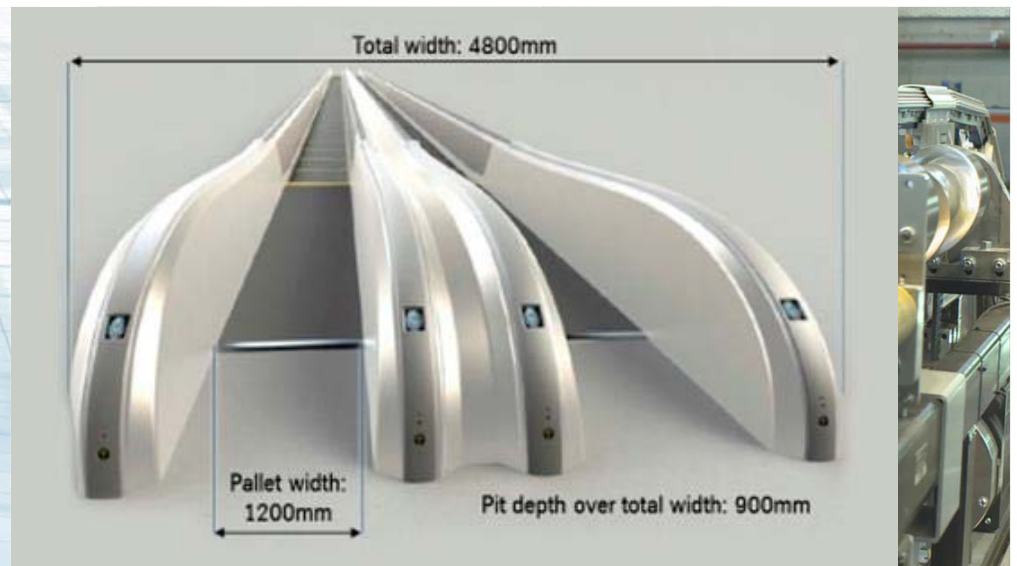
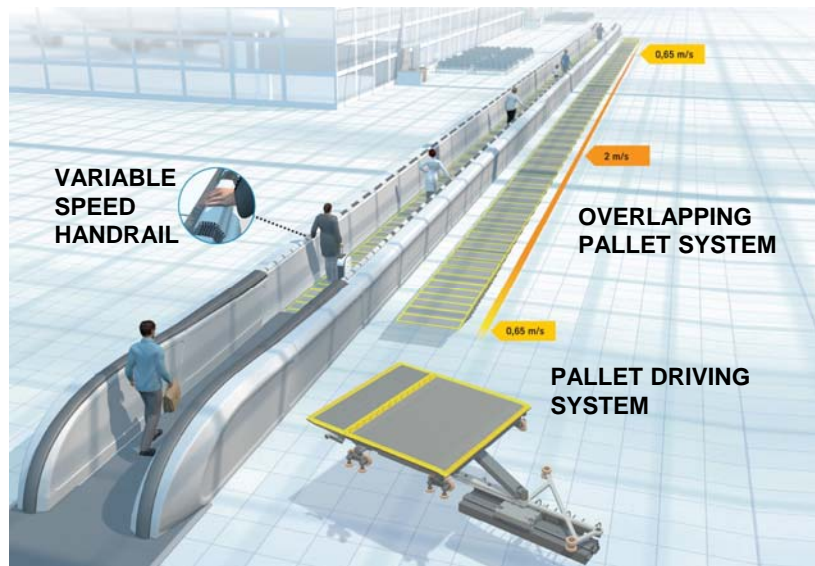

Complexity of Metros increases

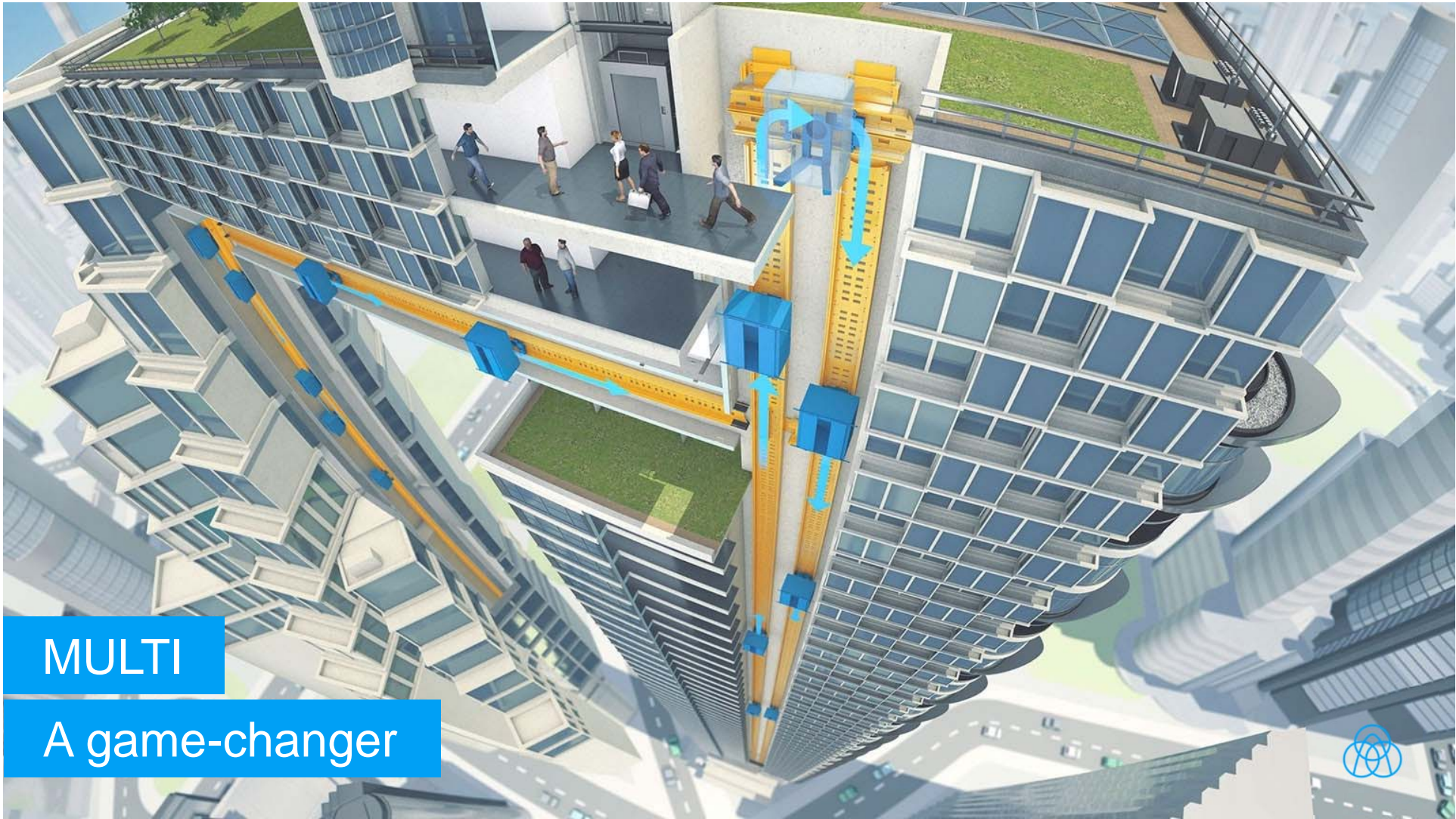
